## 2012 Report from ISWC to the Windsurfing & Kiteboarding Committee

The class activities have, once again, been badly affected by the world economic situation. However, this was not wholly unexpected and the class had planned accordingly.

The focus this year was upon a **European Speed Windsurfing Tour**. The tour comprised 3 events:

- 1) Gruissan Speedweek, France
- 2) German Championship Fehmarn, Germany
- 3) Weymouth Speedweek, Portland Harbour, UK
  This event scheduled for 6<sup>th</sup> >12<sup>th</sup> October was the 40th Anniversary edition

## Criteria for Tour

- Based on the results of accepted European National championships.
- The Male and Female competitors' tour winners will be crowned the European Champions.
- The best of three results to count for the ranking, if a tie exists, then the riders fastest speed
- Tour event organisers must agree to accept minimum standards of speed competition.

There are many other national and regional speed events that are keeping the discipline alive; speed record attempts continue to be made; and the class fully expects to bring back a world championship in the near future.
