Unstoppable

In 2010, the RS:One came to life with the support of Mr NeilPryde to fill the gap between the 2 Olympic Windsurfing classes, the Bic Techno 293 and the NeilPryde RS:X.

The RS:One became an ISAF recognised Class in 2011 allowing the first World Championships held in Boracay in 2012.

In 2013, the RS:One Class became the official windsurfing board for the Sea Games. The RS:One has been also selected as the women Class for the Asian Games 2013 and both genders division for the Asian Beach Games.

The ASAF has chosen the RS:One for the Asian windsurfing youth cup in 2014 and confirmed the RS:One as the official windsurfing board for male and female at the 2018 Asian Games to be held in Indonesia.

Training together

FORMATS

RS:One is a multi generational, one-design windsurfing board featuring an easy and light performing 7.8 rig.

Espoirs (youth under 22), Seniors (under 40) and Masters (older than 40), both men and women, can race together on the same starting line in a collective fleet. The RS: One Class allows all racers to compete through innovative race formats with courses set up in a way that the on-shore audience can enjoy the action. The format also ensures that the winner is the best competitor in all conditions.







REGATTA

The classic race format used by most of the sailing classes with an upwind start, upwind mark and downwind gate. Usually selected in marginal and low wind conditions to secure fair races and maximum number of races. Target time is 25 mns.









PULSAR

The most exciting format featuring a compact downwind slalom with a reaching start before going upwind and finishing by slalom. This modern sailing format inspired by funboard racing and the America's Cup is only raced in planing conditions. Target time is 10 minutes for the best combination of adrenaline and spectacle.









MARATHON

The long distance version requiring endurance skills which can be raced only in suitable conditions (not under 10 knots, not more than 20 knots). Great moments with courses will be set up to deliver maximum visual enjoyment for racers and spectators.
